What's on at Bath City Farm for Young People & Families

The farm offers a variety of activity sessions for families and youngsters of all ages. We are particularly keen to encourage those living closest to the farm to come and take part, but we also offer a regular calendar of community events to bring together people from Bath and beyond to enjoy the farm.



Under 5s

Roots & Shoots: Toddler group

Tuesdays 10-11.30am (monthly in the winter)

*No booking needed, **small charge***

Bring your under 5s along to feed the animals, explore the farm and discover the magic of nature and gardening

5-10 Year Olds

After School Club

Mondays in term time 4-5.30pm

*For local children, **no charge***

A great way to let off steam after the school day. Feed the animals and enjoy some outdoor activities, including campfire making, den building, cooking and wildlife crafting.

Saturday Club

Saturdays year round 10-11.45am

*Blocks of 7 sessions must be booked in advance, **small charge***

Get covered in mud, make a bonfire and cook on it, go on a treasure hunt, make candles, look after wildlife, feed the animals, get crafty, make friends, and have loads of fun!



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One-off School Visits

*Timings flexible, **visits are charged***

We offer 2-hour guided visits, introducing pupils to farming, food production, animal welfare and conservation. Sessions are structured around your learning objectives.

11-16 Year Olds

*For local young people, booking essential, **no charge***

Fire-lighting, campfire cooking, shelter building, woodcarving.

16- 25 Year Olds

Get Green

Tuesdays 1-3pm

*For those not in education or employment, **no charge***

Learn about animal care, horticulture, conservation, cooking, crafting and woodworking. Gain practical experience, as well as transferable skills such as problem solving, team building, communication, time keeping and responsibility, to take into employment or further education.

Supported Work Placements

*Timings are flexible, **placements are charged***

We also offer practical outdoor work placements for students finding it difficult to engage with classroom activities or at risk of exclusion. These placements aim to have a broad positive effect and to improve students' outcomes, including better achievement, standards, motivation and behaviour.
